# WWWF: The Long (Island) & Short Of It

Formally labeled as "Nassau-Suffolk" by Nielsen after the two counties comprising it, Long Island is the nation's 21st largest radio market and stretches



from the New York City limits to the island's eastern tip. Nassau-Suffolk is also an embedded market, which means it is simultaneously part of the New York City market, by which it is often overshadowed.

On March 20, Connoisseur switched its Classic Rock station on Long Island, WBZO, to Country as "The Wolf," with new **WWWF** calls. In its first month, The Wolf scored a 2.9 share (up from WBZO's 2.3). In its second month, The Wolf rose to a 3.1, good for ninth overall and the largest

share for any Country station in the Long Island ratings since 1993, when then-Country WYNY/New York pulled a 3.1. **Country Aircheck** caught up with COO/GM **David Bevins** for a deeper look at the Wolf, which coincidentally joins the Country Aircheck/Mediabase reporting panel with this week's chart.

# CA: What else should we know about the market?

**DB:** Long Island is not New York City. The island has three million people [and] the median age is around 50. Everybody here knows they're living in the shadows of New York, but they take a lot of pride in knowing this is their own market.

# Why the flip?

One of the biggest reasons was perceived need. The Jones Beach Amphitheater seats 15,000, and there were packed country shows there throughout last summer. I'd see people line dancing in the parking lot and think, "How is there not a Country station serving this population?" Nash [WNSH-



FM/New York] exited the marketplace a while ago and it left a void.

Fortunately, we have five stations here. Two were Rock – mainstream, 94.3 The Shark [WWSK] – and 103.1 Max FM [WBZO], with kind of a "Jack" format with no personalities and a lot of

music. WBZO did relatively well but was not meeting our expectations. And we were up against a big Rock station, WBAB. Rather than fighting that battle any longer, we wanted to create a station with a unique format no one else is doing in the marketplace.

# Out-Of-The-Box Anachronisms

Need "max spins?" Was a single "shipped?" Will listeners "tune in" to hear it? The radio and record industries are rife with comically dated jargon,

about which **Country Aircheck** has encouraged them to riff.

"Want the most outdated terms in promotion?" asks Valory VP/Promotion **Chris Palmer**, with a nod to labels' tightened budgets. "T&E," "steakhouse" and "another round." Palmer adds, "'On your desk' has definitely been replaced by 'on your






desktop.' 'Out of the box' has been replaced with, 'I still have two spots to fill on my guitar pull and there are three world premieres coming up that I have to get to. Can we revisit this next month?' 'Massive phones' went away around the time Scott Studios was invented (1996, maybe). And we all

know [Napster's] Sean Parker and Shawn Fanning completely ended the term 'sales.'"

Big Machine VP/Promotion **Erik Powell** adds to the list of terms radio still uses: "It's 'in my short stack' for consideration. Like there is still a stack of CDs on their desk." Warner Music Nashville VP/Radio **Anna Cage** agrees that some of these terms are "super dated," noting that desk and box references are to physical products that are no longer used for radio distribution. She suggests a more realistic "on your desk" might be "in your spam folder now!"

MCC/Curb SVP **Craig Powers** offers "in your email (or downloads) now" as ship date or box alternatives, and wants "tune in" changed to "listen on our app and our FM frequency at ...". "'Here's a new one from ...' could change to 'here's one of the biggest streaming songs from ..."

Stone Country/Quartz Hill VP/Promotion & Marketing **Will Robinson** adds references to "album" and "record" to the list. "With the advent of CDs, we never changed that verbiage, and it has now become synonymous with a collection of music, not the physical element it once was," he says of the former, adding for the latter, "a physical record has now transformed into a collection of ones and zeros." He also cites "top of the hour" and "after the break" as terms "only media people use." And the "brand new song" phrase is even worse. "Even decades ago we'd say this for the fourth single off an album," he notes.

Black River VP/National Promotion **Bill Macky** cites "pre-tape" and "in the can," confessing, "No one uses tape anymore, but I find myself saying these from time to time."

"Sadly old enough to remember when we really shipped records to radio" is GrassRoots Promotion Managing Partner **Nancy Tunick**. "Yes, there was a mail room at labels where CD singles and fun tchotchkes (that's Yiddish for promotional items) were shipped to radio stations! I imagine 'rotations' is a vinyl reference, as the records would rotate or spin on the turntable. [Ed. Note: CDs would spin, too.] I haven't seen a wav file spin, but I still appreciate every spin I can get!

"We are creatures of habit and, as any radio programmer can tell you, familiar equals positive," Tunick continues. "Those terms are familiar

to us, even to those who don't remember how they originated. But if we could be brave and experiment with something new, we could have a blast date instead of a ship date." Intuitively, perhaps, she

suggests sticking with "out of the box," saying, "Programmers are occasionally adding songs out of their inbox."

Some industry pros used the opportunity presented by this story to also share their thoughts on terms that just make them squirm, even if they're not necessarily dated. In consultation

with colleagues **Katie Dean** and **Tracy Gibson**, Leo33 VP/Promotion & Marketing **Chris Fabiani** submits the following phrases they'd prefer never to hear from radio again: "no room/space," "freezing,"

"nothing's moving," "so busy," "wearing so many hats," "we'll see what callout says," "on the short list" and "keeping an eye on it." Similarly, Big Machine's Powell cites as an annoyance radio's use of the term "'I need to spend more time with it' – three months into the release of the single."

# Chart Chat

Congratulations to **Post Malone, Morgan Wallen, Stacy Blythe, Tyler Waugh** and the **Big Loud** promotion team on taking "I Had Some Help" to No. 1. Reaching the top in just eight weeks, Malone's first Country chart topper is the fastest rising No. 1 since Kenny Chesney's "Don't Blink" made an eight-week trek in October 2007 and is just the seventh song this century to reach No. 1 in less than 10 weeks. Songwriters



are Louis Bell, Ryan Vojtesak, Hoskins, Ernest Keith Smith, Ashley Gorley, Chandler Paul Walters, Austin Post and Wallen.

With "Cowgirls" at No. 2, Wallen becomes the first artist to simultaneously be in the top two spots since May 1982, when Willie Nelson was at No. 2 with "Always On My Mind" and at No. 1 on the Waylon Jennings duet "Just To Satisfy You."

Independents' Day: With "She's Somebody's Daughter" moving into the top 10 this week, **Drew Baldridge**'s Lyric Ridge becomes the first artist-supported label to achieve such a feat since **Aaron Watson**'s Big Label took "Outta Style" to No. 8 in 2017.



We still have The Shark reaching the male audience, but now we have a completely new format that is serving a whole new audience.

You mention the 2021 demise of WNSH, and the market also is home to WJVC. Did those factors give you any pause in going Country?



WJVC is a great radio station. Long Island spans 130 miles in length, and WJVC's signal reaches the far east end of the island, which is a less populated area. In contrast, WWWF's tower is centrally positioned, offering a more powerful signal that reaches a larger available audience.

Reflecting on the Nash experience, we initially had our reservations. However, we recognize the distinct demographics of Long Island. I don't believe Nash did very well in the city of New York, but it did well in Nassau County. Before we launch a format, we'd typically do a market analysis and our researcher would recommend where there was opportunity. This time, our team, including VP/Programming Keith Dakin, PD Patrick Shea and Consultant Joel Raab, went with our gut based on what we were seeing and experiencing and how big Country radio is right now.

# You've gotten out of the gate fast, how have you been getting the word out?

We're doing a heavy dose of digital marketing on Long Island with social media, connected TV and pre-roll video. We know the ZIP codes we want to go after. During our first week on the air, we gave away tickets to Zach Bryan every 15 minutes. We created a heat map with where the winners were from, and we were very pleased to see winners coming from all over the island.

# What about traditional marketing?


We are extremely active with our street team. We have a big orange van, an 18-foot inflatable wolf, a lot of giveaway prizes and we're getting involved in as much country stuff as possible. Whether it's paid or not paid, we want to be involved with country events happening on Long Island.

You're still filling out the airstaff and have a local talent (Alexa Neo) in middays, what about the decision to put Big D & Bubba in mornings?

We're of the belief the best talent wins no matter if its local or syndicated. Big D & Bubba are some of the best talent in morning Country radio,

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

and we have a nice relationship with Compass Media. They are very easy to work with and, early on, it's going well. [Ed. Note: In May, WWWF ranked 12th in Persons 6+, 17th 25-54 and 2<sup>nd</sup> 18-34 in morning drive.

# What have you been seeing under the hood in your first two monthlies?

The early ratings have been phenomenal. We are doing very well with the 18-34 audience, and I think what's happening is the Top 40 audience also enjoys brand new country music. We also did well

with men. The men who were listening to Max had a choice to leave or stay, and hopefully some of them stayed.

# What were the initial expectations for The Wolf?

We were just hoping to do a little better than what we were doing with Max. We couldn't be happier with what's happened in two months and how that helps our cluster. The month of May has been the best month for our cluster in four years.

# What's next?

In the immediate future, Jason Aldean is coming to Jones Beach and Jelly Roll is coming to Madison Square Garden. We're hoping to be involved in events in New York City and give each one of them as much promotion

Lyric Ridge's **Drew Baldridge** shares the opportunities (and challenges) of being an independent artist:

It's been quicker and easier to get music out doing it independently, but it also comes with other challenges. For example, there's less of a team to help you promote your music, so you gotta work harder to get your music noticed.

You get to own your own masters, which DREW BALDRIDGE can be life changing, but that also comes at

publicity, radio promotion staff and travel expenses. You really have to believe in yourself and take the risk. Getting DSP playlisting for me has been harder not having a label behind me, but that doesn't mean it's that way for every artist. I've learned

the expense of paying for them, the music videos, the marketing,

you have to build your listeners without playlisting, and I've been blessed to have my first certified gold single without it. One of the cool things I noticed about being independent is I get

to hand pick the team who works with me. I really get to know who has passion for my project and bring them into it

Another lesson I've learned when releasing music with a label or independently is that, no matter what, it's hard. This business is not easy or easier either way you do it. The power is all in the song and in the music.

Baldridge's "She's Somebody's Daughter" is currently at No. 9 on the chart


